



Camp Ground Rules

Welcome to Jesus Camp Resort. These ground rules exist for one reason: to keep the camp safe, the experience peaceful, and the atmosphere honoring to God. By staying with us, you agree to abide by these rules and help us hold one another to them.

1 Check-In & Check-Out

- Check-in begins at **3:00 PM**. Check-out is by **11:00 AM**.
- All guests must check in at the front desk before going to their accommodations.
- Late check-outs require approval at least 24 hours in advance.
- Lost room keys or access cards carry a \$25 replacement fee.

2 Quiet Hours

- Quiet hours are **10:00 PM to 7:00 AM** every night.
- Voices, music, and devices should be kept low during these hours.
- Group meetings and worship are welcome — just keep them in approved gathering spaces during quiet hours.

3 Alcohol, Drugs & Tobacco

- Jesus Camp Resort is a **completely alcohol-free, drug-free, and smoke-free property**.
- No alcohol, illegal substances, vaping, or tobacco of any kind are permitted on the grounds.
- Guests found in violation will be asked to leave immediately, without refund.

4 Pool & Water Activities

- Swimming is only permitted in designated swim areas during posted hours.
- Children under 12 must be accompanied by an adult at all times.
- No glass containers, no diving in shallow areas, no horseplay.

- Swim at your own risk — lifeguards are only on duty when posted.

5 Fire Safety

- Open flames, candles, and incense are not allowed inside cottages or dorms.
- Outdoor fires are only permitted in designated fire pits with staff approval.
- Never leave a fire unattended. Always fully extinguish before leaving.
- Report any smoke, sparking, or fire hazard to staff immediately.

6 Pets

- Pets are **not permitted** on the property except for documented service animals.
- Service animals must be leashed and supervised at all times.
- The guest is responsible for any cleanup or damage caused by their animal.

7 Property & Common Spaces

- Treat every cottage, dorm, dining hall, and gathering space as if it were your own home.
- Report any damage or maintenance issue right away — no one is in trouble for accidents that are reported.
- Willful damage will be billed at the cost of repair.
- Please clean up after yourself in shared kitchens, dining areas, and bathrooms.

8 Children & Youth Groups

- Youth under 18 must be supervised by their group leader or a parent at all times.
- Group leaders are responsible for the conduct of their youth on the property.
- A 2-adult minimum is required for any youth activity.

9 Vehicles & Parking

- Park only in designated parking areas. Do not block roads, paths, or accessible spaces.
- Maximum speed on camp roads is **10 mph**.
- Jesus Camp Resort is not responsible for vehicle damage or theft.

10 Visitors

- Day visitors are welcome but must check in at the front desk.
- Overnight guests must be registered.
- Visitors may not access dorms, cottages, or restricted areas without staff permission.
